On July 6, 2020 SEVP published Broadcast Message 2007-01 - COVID-19 for Fall 2020.

In this announcement SEVP updated guidance for Fall 2020. Previously SEVP had made a temporary adaptation related to online courses allowing international students on F-1 visas to enroll in remote courses in the Spring Quarter 2020 and Summer Sessions 2020.

For Fall 2020, <u>SEVP will require at least one course of in-person enrollment for schools like UCI that will operate with some in-person and remote course options (hybrid) for Fall 2020</u>. We have created the chart below to help you understand your individual situation. The information is subject to change and will be updated as we get new information.
